APPLICABILITY:	Viper SD-4 RTC aircraft equipped with the Rotax 912ULS engine.
SUBJECT:	Exchange of stator assembly for Rotax 912ULS aircraft engine Exchange of propeller shaft on Rotax 912ULS aircraft engine
COMPLIANCE:	Carry out the service bulletin: - on every ROTAX 912 ULS engine installed on Viper SD4 RTC aircraft in service after the date of this service bulletin, and before installation of an ROTAX 912 ULS engine on Viper SD-4 RTC aircraft
DESCRIPTION:	TOMARK, s.r.o. as holder of EASA.A.606 has not identified any of Viper SD-4 RTC aircraft, in service or in production, equipped with a Rotax 912ULS engine that would be affected by MANDATORY Service Bulletins SB-912-077UL and SB-912-078UL issued by the engine manufacturer BRP-Rotax GmbH & CO KG. However, the installation of a Rotax 912ULS engine that is affected by these service bulletins by a maintenance organization on a Viper SD4 RTC aircraft in service cannot be excluded in the future.
REASON:	Internal quality checks of Rotax 912ULS engines manufacturer revealed that due to a deviation in the manufacturing process, some stator assemblies, specified in SB-912077UL, may fail on one ignition circuit, and due to a deviation in the machining process of the propeller shaft, the affected batch, with S/N numbers specified in SB-912-078UL, shows abnormalities on the surface. This could lead to increased wear of the propeller shaft bearings and subsequent serious engine problems.

ACCOMPLISHMENT INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) For aircraft in operation, it must be checked **before next flight** to ensure that it does not match the engine group listed in the Rotax SB-912-077UL or Rotax SB-912-078UL documents. If it does, the instructions in Rotax SB-912-077 Replacement of Stator Assembly for Rotax 912 (Series) Aircraft Engines and Rotax SB-912-078 Propeller Shaft Replacement for ROTAX Type 912 (Series) Engines must be followed prior to next flight.
- 2) For each newly installed engine in a Viper SD4 RTC aircraft in service, it must be checked to ensure that it does not match the engine group listed in the Rotax SB-912-077UL or Rotax SB-912-078UL documents. If it does, the instructions in Rotax SB-912-077 Replacement of Stator Assembly for Rotax 912 (Series) Aircraft Engines and Rotax SB-912-078 Propeller Shaft Replacement for ROTAX Type 912 (Series) Engines must be followed prior to installation.
